They will be held across the borough until the autumn promoting and offering residents personalised one-to-one appointments with a member of our team. This project is part funded by the UK government through the UK Shared Prosperity Fund.

The events and appointments are designed to:

- Make sure everyone struggling with the cost-of-living is able to get help.
- Reach out to people that use community organisations but might not know what additional help is available to them.
- Achieve measurable reductions in poverty and improvements in financial well-being.
- Generate referrals to our Financial Resilience Broxtowe* project.

***Financial Resilience Broxtowe** is a project designed to work proactively with people and households who find it difficult to manage financially. It works with them to create a long-term plan towards financial resilience. This includes:

- Increasing income
- Reduced spending and ability to budget
- Building a safety net and protecting assets
